Concept Note

International Day of Sports for the Development and Peace on 6th April, 2019 Due to its vast reach, unparalleled popularity and foundation of positive values, sport is ideally positioned to contribute towards the United Nations' objectives for development and peace.

To raise awareness of this potential, 6 April was declared as the International Day of Sport for Development and Peace (IDSDP) by the UN General Assembly. The adoption of this Day signifies the increasing recognition by the UN of the positive influence that sport can have on the advancement of human rights, and social and economic development.

Many organizations of the UN system, including the International Forum on Sport, Peace and Development, organized jointly with the UN Office on Sport for Development and Peace, have already established partnerships with the International Olympic

Committee. The mission and role of the Committee, as set out in the Olympic Charter, are placing sport at the service of human kind and promoting a peaceful society and healthy lifestyles by associating sport with culture and education and safeguarding human dignity without any discrimination whatsoever.

Resolution adopted by the General Assembly on 26 October 2015 [without reference to a Main Committee (A/70/L.3 and Add.1)] 70/4.

Building a peaceful and better world through sport and the Olympic ideal The General Assembly, Recalling its resolution 68/9 of 6 November 2013, in which it decided to include in the provisional agenda of its seventieth session the sub-item entitled “Building a peaceful and better world through sport and the Olympic ideal”, and recalling also its prior decision to consider the sub-item every two years, in advance of the Summer and Winter Olympic Games, Recalling also its resolution 48/11 of 25 October 1993, which, inter alia, revived the ancient Greek tradition of ekecheiria (“Olympic Truce”) calling for a truce during the Olympic Games to encourage a peaceful environment and ensure safe passage, access and participation for athletes and relevant persons at the Games, thereby mobilizing the youth of the world to the cause of peace, Recalling further that the core concept of ekecheiria, historically, has been the cessation of hostilities from seven days before until seven days after the Olympic Games, which, according to the legendary oracle of Delphi, was to replace the cycle of conflict with a friendly athletic competition every four years, Recognizing the valuable contribution of sport in promoting education, sustainable development, peace, cooperation, solidarity, fairness, social inclusion and health at the local, regional and international levels.

Welcoming the designation of 6 April as the International Day of Sport for Development and Peace because Sports can contribute to an atmosphere of tolerance and understanding among peoples and nations.

BRIEF INTRODUCTION OF SIR DEEN BANDHU CHHOTU RAM JI

Sir Chhotu Ram, (born **Ram Richpal**; 24 November 1881 – 9 January 1945) was a prominent politician in British India's Punjab Province, an ideologue of the pre-Independent India, who belonged to the [Jat](#) community and championed the interest of oppressed communities of the Indian Sub-continent. For this feat, he was knighted in 1937. On political front, he was a co-founder of the National Unionist Party which ruled the United Punjab Province in pre Independent India and kept Congress and Muslim League at bay

About the DCRUST University

Deen bandhu Chhotu Ram University of Science and Technology (DCRUST), formerly **Chhotu Ram State College of Engineering, Murthal (CRSCE)**, is a state university located in Murthal, Sonapat, Haryana, India. It was founded in 1986 by the Government of Haryana in memory of Sir Chhotu Ram (1881–1945). It was then known as the Chhotu Ram State College of Engineering, Murthal until the government of Haryana upgraded it to University on 6 November 2006 through an Act 29 of 2006 of the Legislature of the state of Haryana. The University has been considered eligible for grants under Section 12(B) of UGC Act, 1956 in March, 2009.

Location The university is located in Murthal on National Highway No. 44 at a distance of 50 km from Inter State Bus Terminal, Delhi and at a distance of 8 km from Sonipat railway station. The campus of the college has been developed on 273 acres (1.10 km²) of land that falls within the industrial and commercial belt extending from Kundli to Panipat

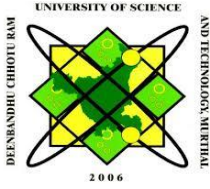
