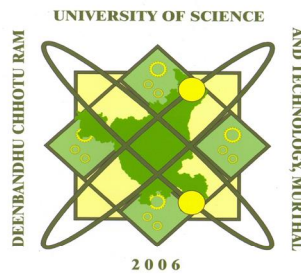

Item No. 9_8 To consider and approve the topic and supervisor of Ms. Anita Singh D/o Sh. Bhoop Singh admitted for Ph.D. in Centre of Excellence for Energy and Environmental Studies during the academic session 2012-13.

Considered and approved Dr. Sudesh Choudhary, Assistant Professor as Supervisor of **Ms. Anita Singh, D/o Sh. Bhoop Singh, Ph.D. Scholar in Centre of Excellence for Energy and Environmental Studies** and her topic of research was amended and approved as *'Analysis and remediation of heavy metals in water and soil of Yamuna River flood plain'*

Item No. 9_9 To consider and approve the increase in intake of students to UG and PG programmes in the University from the Academic Session 2015-16.

The Council noted the in principle decision of Executive Council notified vide item No. 23_16 in the meeting of its meeting held on 5.11.2014 to increase the students intake upto one-and-a-half times in the UG and PG Programmes of the University from the academic session 2015-16. It was further decided that details be worked out by the respective departments.

Item No. 9_10 To consider and approve the instructions received from the State Government regarding prescribing minimum eligibility qualification for the various courses being run by the University.

The Council approved the instructions received from the State Government vide letter No.3870-WGI-ASOH-64/200069 dated 6th/9th October, 1964 whereby the candidates of Scheduled Caste and Schedule Tribes provided 5% reduction in marks in the minimum eligibility qualification for the various courses being run by the University. These are reproduced below:-

: 6 :

¶In a course, a general candidate requires to have 50% marks, then as per Govt. instructions by giving 5% relaxation the minimum eligibility marks for a reserved caste candidate should be calculated as under:-

Out of 100 marks needs to less = 5

Out of 1 marks needs to less = 5/100

Out of 50 marks needs to less = 5/100 x 50 = 2.50

This way minimum less marks where general category candidates are required to have 50% in a prescribed qualification, the total required marks for a reserved candidates will be 50-2.50 = 47.50 and not 45.ö

Item No.9_11 To consider and approve the restructuring of Question Papers of Ist and IInd semester of B. Tech/BBA/BCA/BHM/5 years Integrated Programs

It was resolved that the UG question papers for the first and second semester will have nine questions each. First question consisting of objective/ short answer sub parts will be set from the complete syllabus and will be compulsory. Remaining eight questions will be distributed among four sections, two questions in each section. Students will be required to answer one questions from each section.

Item No.9_12 To consider and approve Ph.D. candidature of Sh. Satpal, Assistant Professor and Sh. Parveen Kumar, Associate Professor, Department of Architecture

It was informed by Dean and the Chairperson of the Department of Architecture that the matter for qualification was subjudice. The Academic Council, therefore, resolved that since the matter is subjudice in the Court, the status quo will continue till the finalization of the Court case. It was further resolved that in future no matter which is subjudice in the Court of law be put up before the Academic Council.

Item No. 9_13 To consider and approve the admissions to Ph.D. programme during the Academic Session 2014-15

It was noted that 64 students have been selected for Ph.D. programme for the academic session 2014-15 out of which 58 students have joined. It was decided that the DRC of every department must prepare waiting list, if any, of the candidates and a cutoff date be fixed for admission. .

Further resolved that conversion of reserved seats to other category(ies) is not allowed in Ph.D. programme.

Item No.9_14 To consider and approve the request of Sh. Pankaj Mukhija, Lab Technician Grade-‘A’ for pursuing Ph.D. from Deenbandhu Chhotu Ram University of Science & Technology, Murthal

The Academic Council considered and approved that Sh. Pankaj Mukhija, Lab Technician Grade-‘A’ be allowed to pursue Ph.D. from Deenbandhu Chhotu Ram University of Science & Technology, Murthal provided that his regular work will not be affected. It was further resolved that in future any faculty/staff member should apply for No Objection Certificate prior to the submission of application for higher studies.

Item No.9_15 To consider and approve the amendment in rule for awarding degree with honours and award of Gold Medal

The Academic Council considered and approved the amendment in the rules for awarding Degree with Honours and award of Gold Medal. The amended rules are as under :-

Amended rules for award of Gold Medal

One University Gold Medal shall be awarded for each discipline instead of each programme run by the university to a meritorious candidate i.e. one medal in each B.Tech (CSE), B.Tech (ECE) etc. and similarly for M.Tech and M.Sc. Programmes.

One Chancellor medal shall be awarded to an outstanding student of the university on the basis of distinguished performance in academic and extra-curricular activities with effect from the Academic Session 2015-16 for UG/PG programmes.

The following shall be the criteria for award of Gold Medal:

1. The minimum requirement of CGPA for a candidate to be eligible for award of Gold Medal shall be 6.32 (1st division).
2. a) The candidate (s) must have passed the examination in the regular period of the programme in first attempt/sitting semester and year wise i.e. there has been no re-appear in any subject (s)/ course (s) during the period of his/ her study. However, if a candidate pass the subject(s) after re-evaluation of the main examination then it shall be treated as single attempt. Such re-evaluated marks shall be considered for ascertaining the award of Gold Medal.
b) The candidate who got re-appear on account of absence in any paper/subject in exam will not be eligible for award of gold medal.
3. For those Programmes where there is a requirement of thesis/dissertation for the partial fulfillment of the degree, the candidates who have submitted their thesis/dissertation up to 30th of June of the final academic year of their studies shall be considered for the award of Gold Medal.
4. The final decision for award of Gold Medal shall be taken after completion of re-evaluation process of the final semester examination in that particular programme.
5. The candidate who has secured highest CGPA among the eligible candidates (As per the criteria 1-4 above) shall be awarded the Gold Medal.

6. In case, two or more candidates have secured the same CGPA, the following criteria, in order of preference, shall be followed to decide the Gold Medal.
 - a) The candidate who has secured higher/highest CGPA by considering up to 3rd decimal of CGPA shall stand higher in rank.
 - b) The candidate with highest actual marks/scores obtained in final year shall stand higher in rank.
 - c) The candidate with highest actual marks/scores obtained in theory papers only of the end semester examinations of the final year shall stand higher in rank.
7. Gold Medal shall not be awarded for those programme where strength of class is less than 10.
8. The specifications of the medal will be approved by the Vice-Chancellor.

Modified rule for award of UG/PG Degree with Honours

Conversion of CGPA into Marks (Multiplied by 9.5)

Candidates who pass all the prescribed subjects for all the semesters, but obtained:-

With Honours provided that they have passed all the examinations in single sitting within the normal period of course and without re-appear in any paper throughout the programme will be awarded aforesaid division.

The candidate who got re-appear on account of absence in any paper/subject in exam will not be eligible for award of degree with honour.

Item No.9_16 To consider and approve the expansion of Language Laboratory in terms of physical space, manpower, hardware and software

The Council considered and approved the expansion of Language Laboratory in terms of physical space, manpower, hardware and software. Teaching of Sanskrit will also be a part of the language laboratory. It was further resolved that all the affiliated colleges be also informed to start such language laboratory classes in the colleges.

Item No. 9_17 To consider and approve the increase in credit of the Sports in the General proficiency

The Academic Council considered and approved the increase in the credits of Sports and Co-curricular activities in General proficiency from 2 to 4 credits. This scheme will be applicable for the students admitted in the academic session 2015-16 and onwards.

- Item No. 9_18 To note and ratify the action taken by Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor for approving the topic of research of Sh. Sandeep Rajan, Registration No. 09171008, Ph.D. Scholar, in the Department of Physics**

The Academic Council noted and ratified the action for approving the topic of Research of Sh. Sandeep Rajan, Registration No. 09171008, research scholar, Department of Physics as per recommendations of then Board of Post Graduate Studies and Research. Modified topic of research is -Investigations of Structural, Magnetic and Electronic Properties of Intermetallic Nanomaterials.ø
