
Subject: Minutes of the meeting regarding Examination of B. Vocational Courses

The decision taken in the 14th meeting of Academic Council under item No. 14.41 regarding B. Vocational programme running in the University have been informed and discussed with the students. All queries raised by students were addressed. The following decisions were taken in the meeting.

1. The scheme, syllabi, ordinance running of programme shall be as per UGC guidelines of B. Voc for the remaining period of study.
2. University will complete the course in full time mode as per UGC guidelines.
3. University will conduct the examinations of B. Voc. (all courses studied by the students during last semester) within 15 days.
4. MOU with partner industries / SSC / NSDC will be done immediately to complete the skill component of these courses (year wise student should earn 24 credit of general education and 36 credits of skill component: one credit is equivalent to 14-15 hours for theory courses and 28-30 hours of lab. courses and skill component / on job training).



5. Scholarship for the semester taught be released to the students of the programme and no further scholarship shall be awarded for the remaining time period of the course (not applicable for employed students).
6. Students, if employed anywhere else, are advised to submit relieving certificate from their employer and shall take study leave for the remaining period of the course.
7. If any student is interested to withdraw from the course then the University fees and hostel room rent paid (hosteller) shall be refunded to the students.
8. Students were advised to submit an application to Registrar office by 15th July, 2019 whether they are interested to continue the course or withdrawal from the course immediately or take exit at a particular stage.

This is issued with the approval of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor.




